This Agreement, made and entered into this 24th day of August 1906, by and between Jeff Harrison, of Broken Arrow, I. T. for himself a citizen of the Creek Nation party of the first part and the Broken Arrow Loan & Investment Co. party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made by the party of the second part, the party of the first part this day and by these presents do demise and let to the party of the second part its heirs and assigns, for Agricultural purposes, for the term of three years, from the first day of January 1907 the following described parcels of land: North East 1/4 of the N. E. Quarter of Section 1 Township 18 N., Range 14 E.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the second part will pay said party of the first part a rental of \$33.33 per annum during the term of this contract payable as follows:

One Hundred dollars in advance, paid this 24th day of August, 1906, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.
