Know All Men By These Presents: That we, W. E. Culling and Sarah W. Culling, his wife of the City of Chillicothe, County of Livingston, State of Missouri, for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand No/100 Dollars to us in hand paid by Katherine Leaver, of Chillicothe, Livingston County, Missouri, the receipt whereof is hereunto acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Katherine Leaver, and unto her heirs and assigns, executors and administrators forever, the following described real estate situated, lying and being in Western District, Creek Nation, Indian Territory, known as Lot numbered two (2) and three (3) of Block numbered two hundred and four (204) in the town of Tulsa, Indian Territory according to the survey and plat of same.

With all the privileges, affittances, and improvements thereon situate, afftaining and thenuts belonging; To Have and To Hold the same unto the said Katherine Leaver, her heirs and assigns, executors and administrators forever. And the said W. E. Culling and Sarah W. Culling, his wife, for themselves, their heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Katherine Leaver, her heirs, executors and administrators that they are lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforesaid granted premises; that they are free from all encumbrances; that they have good and lawful right to sell and convey the same as herein done; that they will, and that their heirs and executors shall forever warrant and defend the title to the same to the quiet enjoyment of the said Katherine Leaver, her heirs and assigns, executors and administrators, against all lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever. And I, Sarah W. Culling, wife of the said W. E. Culling, the grantor herein do hereby join in this conveyance and for the consideration aforesaid, do convey, release, relinquish and renounce forever all my right, claim and title of dower in her husband in and toward property.
