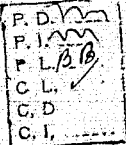

Contract.



This contract made and entered into this 25th day of August A.D. 1906, by and between Christena Tyner party of the first part and C. W. Eaton, his heirs or assigns party of the second part Witnesseth - That for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred & twenty dollars payable as here in after set forth, the party of the first part rents to the party of the second part for agricultural purposes for five years from January 1st 1906, the following described land to wit - the North One half (1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty Five (25) Township Twenty Two (22) North of Range Twelve (12) East containing eighty acres more or less, payment to be made as follows, Ten dollars cash in hand the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Seventy dollars payable January 1st 1907, at which time party of the first part agrees to give full possession of land and premises to the party of the second part his heirs Tenants or assigns, Eighty dollars payable January 1st 1908, Eighty dollars payable January 1st 1909, and Eighty dollars payable January 1st 1910.
