Know all Men by These Presents, That International Land Company, (Incorporated) of Muskogee, Indian Territory, for the consideration of Five hundred Dollars, to it duly paid by George W. Adams, of Tulsa, D.T. (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George W. Adams, the following described real estate lying and being situated in Creek Indian Territory to-wit: All of the South half of the north west quarter of the north east quarter and the south half of the north half of the north west quarter of the north east quarter of Section seventeen (17) Township eighteen (18) north Range thirteen (13) east. Also the north half of the north half of the south half of the south half of the south west quarter of the south east quarter of Section sixteen (16) Township nineteen (19) north Range thirteen (13) east, of the Indian Base and Meridian of the Indian Territory and according to the Government Survey thereof, together with all and singular the improvements, rights and appurtenances thereto belonging.

To Have and to Hold unto the said grantee his heirs and assigns forever. And the said grantor hereby covenants with the said grantee that at the sealing of these presents, the premises above described are free from all incumbrances and that the said International Land Company will warrant and defend the title thereto to the said grantee his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
