Agreement.

This agreement made and entered into this the 6th day of Feb. 1903 by and between G. E. Stiles party of the first part and — party of the second part. Witnesseth: Party of the first part agrees to furnish 65 acres of the land known as the "Moose's Natchez Stump Grounds, Alt." Said land being the 65 acres lying directly south of the 80 acre lease of Messrs. Gilman & Stewart located on said allotment.

Party of the second part agrees to clear up and put in cultivation all the tillable land on said 65 acres build a two room box house size 12 x 24 feet build lot fences corral stables & set set out and care for 100 fruit trees. (Party of the first part to pay for the trees) and is to have the use of the lands hereinafter clear up for two years beginning January 1, 1903 and ending March 1, 1905. He further agrees to pay \$2.25 per acre per annum for the old ground that is now in cultivation on the east side and agrees to pay \$2.25 per acre per annum for all the improved and cultivated lands for a term of 3 years beginning March 1, 1905 and ending March 1, 1908 to pay same 1/2 July 1 & Jan 1 each year. It is understood and agreed by both parties that a block 300 feet square is to be reserved at the place where the "Stump Grounds" were, and the timber not to be cut from same.
