Know All Men By These Presents: That U. R. Evans, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and confessed, do hereby grant, quitclaim, bargain, sell and release unto Delaney/Bowlin and Eliza Bowlin, his wife, all my right, title, and interest in and to the following described land, to wit:

All of Lot Three (3), and the South Fifty (50) feet of Lot Two (2), both in Block One Hundred and Seventy (170), in the Town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the original plat of the town, as approved by the Secretary of the Interior April 11, 1902.

This instrument being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage, dated the 21st day of September, 1905, filed for record in the office of the Deputy Clerk and Ex-officio Recorder at Sapulpa, Indian Territory, on the 22nd day of September, 1905, recorded in Book "L" Page 451, given by Delaney/Bowlin and Eliza Bowlin, his wife, to U. R. Evans, to secure the payment of an indebtedness of One Thousand (\$1000.00) dollars, said mortgage having been fully paid and satisfied.
