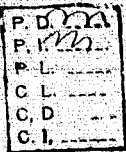

Now and in consideration of full payment, the receipt of which is this day acknowledged, A. V. Draper, hereby releases and discharges a certain mortgage, executed by Rudolph C. Rebholz and Emma Rebholz his wife to A. V.
