Know all Men By These Presents: That The Farmers National Bank of Tulsa, D.T. through its president C. W. Smith for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to me paid by W. H. Penwell do hereby grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said W. H. Penwell and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South Half of the South East Quarter of Section Two, Township 12, North, & Range 13 East, Containing 80 acres more or less, & being in the Western District, & Creek Nation.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain Mortgage dated May 15, 1906, and filed May 19, 1906 in Book L at Page 44 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, by W. H. Penwell & wife Annie Penwell conveying said real estate to Farmers National Bank of Tulsa, D.T. to secure the payment of One certain Note therein named, the same having been fully paid, with interest.
