

mortgage, and shall bear interest from the time of the payment thereof at the rate of eight percent per annum, payable on demand.

And for the consideration aforesaid, and for divers other good and valuable considerations, I, Jessica V. Reeder, wife of said Charles L. Reeder, do hereby release and quit claim unto the said Annie Taylor Jones, her heirs and assigns, all my right, claim, or possibility of dower in or out of the aforesaid premises.

Conditioned, however, that if the said Charles L. Reeder and Jessica V. Reeder, their executors, administrators or assigns shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said Annie Taylor Jones, her executors, administrators, or assigns, the aforesaid sums of money with interest thereon according to the tenor of said notes, then this instrument shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

It is further understood and agreed that if payment be not made, upon any or all of the notes enumerated above upon maturity thereof, the whole shall become due and payable at once and proceeding may be had under this mortgage as if the time for which said notes were given, and all of them, had elapsed.
