

Such payment may be made direct to William Ward lessor or deposited to his credit in Bank of Commerce of Tulsa, D.T. And in the event that the first two wells drilled upon the said lease shall produce one hundred barrels each for sixty consecutive days after being equipped for pumping there and in that event the lessee agrees to pay to lessor the additional sum of five hundred dollars. The gauge of said wells to be determined by the five line gauge which shall be conclusive and binding upon both parties.

It is agreed, that the second party is to have the privilege of using sufficient water, oil and gas, from the premises to run all necessary machinery and at any time to remove all buildings, machinery and fixtures placed on said premises; and further, upon the payment of one dollar, at any time, by the party of the second part, their heirs or assigns, or by a deposit of said sum, together with all amounts due hereunder, in Bank of Commerce aforesaid, said party of the second part, their heirs or assigns, shall have the right to surrender this lease for cancellation and a delivery of said lease to first party in person or a deposit of the same with the money in the Bank of Commerce of Tulsa, D.T. Bank aforesaid, shall operate as a complete surrender of all of second party, their heirs or assigns interest in said property, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue, under and by virtue of its terms, shall cease and determine and this lease become absolutely null and void.

All provisions hereof shall extend to the heirs, successors and assigns of the respective parties hereto.
