

The party of the first part shall have the right and privilege of running, at their own risk, sufficient gas for one dwelling house from any gas well found on said described premises, they to make their own connections at said well.

It is agreed that the party of the second part shall have the privilege of ^{using} sufficient water from the premises to run all necessary machinery, and at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures ^{from} said premises; and further, upon the payment of \$5.00 dollars, at any time thereafter by the party of the second part, its successors, heirs or assigns, or by deposit of said sum together with all amounts due hereunder in the First Nat Bank, the said party of the second, its heirs or assigns, shall have the right to surrender this lease for cancellation, and delivery of said lease to the party of the first part in full and discharge of the same, with the money in the said First Nat Bank shall operate as a complete surrender of all of the interests of the said party of the second part, its heirs or assigns, in this said property after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue, under and by virtue of its terms, shall cease and determine and this lease shall become absolutely null and void.
