Deed of Release.

Henry Knisel

Know All Men By These Presents: That H. S. Corliss, as mortgagee in mortgage first mentioned below and C. W. Knickerbocker, and H. S. Corliss as mortgagees last mentioned below, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to us paid by Henry Knisel, do hereby grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said Henry Knisel and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Creek Nation, Western District, of the Indian Territory to-wit:

Lots numbered 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Block 45 and Lots 1, 4 and 5 in Block 76 all in the town of Tulsa, Indian Territory. This deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated Nov. 12, 1902, filed Nov. 13, 1902 in office of Clerk of the U. S. Court and Ex-officio Recorder at Muskogee, D. S., recorded in Book C 2 at page 228 wherein Henry Knisel conveyed the aforescribed real estate to H. S. Corliss to secure payment of note for \$1005.00 therein named, the same having been fully paid, and

also Lots 3, 4, 5 and 6 in Block 45 and Lots 1, 4 and 5 in Block 76, except 25 feet on East side of Lot 4 Block 76, all in said town of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

This deed also being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated Nov. 21, 1902, and recorded January 21, 1903 in book 22 at Page 76 of the records of the Clerk of the U. S. Court and Ex-officio Recorder at Muskogee, Indian Territory, wherein Henry Knisel conveyed said real estate last named to C. W. Knickerbocker and H. S. Corliss to secure the payment of one note for \$309.50 therein named, the same having been fully paid.

The above conveyance and release being made in lieu of and to correct and complete a former release dated February 7, 1903 from the first named mortgage and the last named mortgagees above mentioned to Henry Knisel referring to the mortgages and property above named.
