

It is mutually understood and agreed that in case of forfeiture or a surrender of the land by the party of the second part, any and all of the covenants and agreements herein made by it shall be null and void and said party of the second part shall be fully released from the payment of any unpaid balance of the purchase price on the interest thereon, and any sum unpaid at the time of such forfeiture or surrender.

It is mutually understood and agreed that no cash royalty for gas shall be required of the party of the second part with the same as hereinafter set out.
