Ella Harner,

This agreement made and entered into this 20th day of September 1906 by and between Lucy Penyman, a single woman; Party of first Part and Ella Harner Party of Second Part, Witnesseth:-

That said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred dollars to be in hand paid by Ella Harner, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, hereby leases to said Ella Harner all her right title and interest in and to the Southwest quarter of the northeast Quarter of section 36, T 19 North, Range twelve East, for a term of five years commencing on the 20th day of September 1906. It being agreed that said property shall be used for Agricultural purposes and kept in good condition and farmed in reasonable manner.

As a further covenant in this lease it is agreed that Ella Harner shall purchase the interest of the said Lucy Penyman in said property and shall pay her for her interest on a basis of Twelve Hundred Dollars for the entire forty acres. The receipt of Three Hundred dollars is hereby acknowledged as payment for said interest, subject to the condition that if in the probating of the estate of Ab. Penyman, her deceased husband, the court shall determine that said Lucy Penyman has an interest in exceeding one-fourth of the estate then the said Ella Harner shall pay to said Lucy Penyman such excess as the same shall amount to on a basis of Twelve Hundred Dollars for the entire forty acres.
