That we, Annie Taylor Jones and James K. Jones Jr, her husband, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to us paid by R. K. Johnson do hereby grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said R. K. Johnson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, to-wit:

The west fifty (50) feet of Lots seven (7) and eight (8) in Block one hundred and two (102) now in and forming a part of the Town of Inow of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain mortgage dated June 30, 1904 and recorded July 1, 1904 in Book 1 at Page 69 of the records of the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory by R. K. Johnson and Antwett Johnson, his wife, conveying said real estate to Annie Taylor Jones to secure the payment of seven certain promissory notes therein named, the same having been fully paid.
