Know All Men By These Presents, That the Alliance Trust Company, Limited, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, does hereby constitute and appoint George Murray, of Kansas City, Missouri, its attorney in fact, to act, in the United States of America and its Territories, and as such in its name and behalf to do the things and act and have powers as follows and for the following purposes, to wit: To sell and convey any and all lands, hereditaments, and without recovers to sell, assign, and transfer mortgages, liens, notes, bills, checks, judgments, and other property or rights which do now or may hereafter belong to it, the said corporation, or in which it is or may become interested, situate in any of the United States or its Territories, and to execute, acknowledge and deliver all necessary deeds, assignments, transfers, releases and discharges therefor; also to lease lands, collect debts, bring suits or authorize the bringing of the same, compromise and settle demands, rights and claims, discharge mortgages and judgments, accept delivery of deeds, mortgages, notes or other evidences of indebtedness, and assign the same without recovers, and to release and discharge deeds of trust, mortgages, or other liens of any kind whatsoever; also to collect rents and any other moneys due or coming due in any manner whatsoever, and to give proper discharges and releases therefor.
