Ordinance No. 149.

And Ordinance granting to C. L. Reeder, J. M. Hagler, Robert Salbreath and Frank Chesley, their associates, successors and assigns, permission to construct, operate and maintain pipe lines for the use of natural gas, up and along all streets and alleys, public grounds and highways of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

Be it Ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, as follows:

Section 1.- That C. L. Reeder, J. M. Hagler, Robert Salbreath and Frank Chesley, their associates, successors and assigns, who shall be known herein as the granters, are hereby given permission to use all of the streets, alleys, public grounds, and highways, within the present and future limits of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, for the purpose of laying pipe lines to furnish said city and inhabitants thereof, and the companies and corporations therein, with natural gas for all purposes for which gas is or can be used, (for term of twenty-five years from the date of the passage and publication of this permit), and shall have the right to use all streets, alleys, public grounds and highways of said city for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating such pipe lines: Provided: That in all cases where practicable said pipe line shall be laid in the alleys.

Section 2.- That in laying and constructing said mains, regulators, and appliances, and in the exercise of the rights and privileges herein permitted, no streets, alleys, public grounds or highways shall at any time be unnecessarily obstructed, and all such excavations or openings made therein by said granters, their successors or assigns, shall within a reasonable time be repaired and placed in as good condition as they were before such excavations or openings were made, and that if any excavation, opening or ditch in any of the streets, alleys, public grounds or highways of the said city shall be left open or unrepaired by said granters, their successors or assigns, or any unnecessary obstruction left thereon or any violation of this section, said city may cause such excavations, openings or ditches to be repaired, and the expense of repairing shall be charged to the said granters, their successors or assigns.

Section 3.- That said granters, their successors or assigns shall not charge for the use of the said gas they may furnish to the said city, or any inhabitants thereof, a sum in excess of twenty (20) cents per thousand cubic feet of natural gas when used for domestic heat or fuel or light; provided, that small consumers who are meter making pay their bills on or before the tenth day of the month succeeding that in which the same is used, shall be entitled to a discount of 20% and when gas is furnished by said granters for factory purposes, and not more than 500,000 cubic feet per day, the rate in such cases shall not exceed six cents per thousand, and where 500,000 cubic feet or more is used per day, the rate shall not exceed 4 cents per thousand cubic feet; provided, however, the granters reserve the right to make special rates to large consumers and provided, that said granters shall furnish all would be consumers of gas at not to exceed these rates so long as said granters have sufficient gas to do so.

Section 4.- In constructing, repairing and operating said gas system said granters or their successors or assigns shall use every reasonable and profitable precaution to avoid injury to persons or property and shall hold and save harmless from any damages or injury, loss or expense to said city caused by said granters, their successors or assigns, in said construction, repairing and operating and operating of said gas system, and in the laying, repairing or repairing of said streets, alleys or public grounds or highways of said city.

Section 5.- That the said granters, their successors or assigns, shall within thirty days from the acceptance of this permit execute and file with the City Recorder of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, a bond in the sum of three thousand (\$3,000) dollars, conditioned that the said granters, their successors or assigns will
