Chattel Mortgage With Power of Sale.

This Indenture, made this 15 day of August, 1906, between G. W. Chilton, party of the first part, and George Blivens party of the second part.

Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred and sixty-six-100 dollars, \$666.66 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part has bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does hereby bargain, sell and convey to the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the following described property to-wit: One sorrel horse six years old, white face and four white legs from knees down, branded on left hip and shoulder with a B. One sorrel horse six years old not branded, white face and front legs white from knees down. One bay horse named Shire, about 9 years old, not branded.

One grey horse, named Guy, about 9 years old not branded. One brown horse named Pat 6 years old, weight 1250. One brown horse named Mike 9 years old, weight 1250. One sorrel mare named Kirt, white face 7 years old. One sorrel mare named Bess, star in forehead 6 years old. One sorrel horse named John, about 10 years old, blind in one eye weight 1500. One sorrel horse named Chris 7 years old weight 1000.

One sorrel horse named Bell, 8 years old white face, weight 850. One sorrel horse named Red weight 900. One sorrel horse named Bell, white face and four white legs from knees down, about 8 years old. One sorrel horse named Jim white strip in face branded T W on left hip and small circle on left shoulder. One sorrel horse named Frank small white

strip in face. One bay horse named Bill 6 years old, weight 900 small white stripe in face. One bay horse named Bert, weight 850, white strip in face, 7 years old. One buckskin horse named Buck, weight 850, branded with buckle on left hip and on left shoulder. One sorrel horse named Prince, about 8 years old weight 850.

One note for \$500.00 payable November 15-1907

And the said party of the first part represents and states that said described property is owned by said party of the first part free and clear of any lien, mortgage or incumbrance of any kind on the same or any part thereof, and that said property is in the actual possession and control of said party of the first part.

The party of the first part shall retain possession and control and have the ordinary use and benefit of said described property at his own expenses until default or until a breach of one or more of the conditions of this mortgage. The party of the first part shall use reasonable care and judgment to preserve and keep all of said property in good condition. The increase of any of said property shall remain with, and be deemed a part of said mortgage security and subject to the lien of this mortgage. The party of the first part shall not cause or permit said property or any part thereof to become subject to any lien or incumbrance of any kind other than this mortgage without the written consent of the party of the second part.
