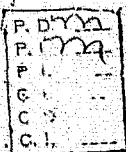

Know all Men By These Presents: That the City National Bank of Tulsa, Indian Territory for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to it in hand paid by W. L. Britton, do hereby grant, sell, quit-claim and release unto the said W. L. Britton and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory to wit: The North half of the North half (N $\frac{1}{2}$ of N $\frac{1}{2}$) of Lot number Four (4), and the South half of Lot number Five (5) Block numbered One Hundred forty-four (144) in the town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the official plat and survey thereof. This deed being made to release the lien of a certain Mortgage dated October 7th 1903, Filed, but not for record on October 16th 1903 at 9 A.M. and designated as File No. 1756, in the office of the Deputy Clerk of the U.S. Court and Ex-Officio Recorder at Muskogee, Indian Territory, wherein said W. L. Britton conveyed said real estate to the City National Bank of Tulsa, D.T. to secure the payment of a certain note for \$300.00 in said mortgage named, the same having been fully paid. Dated at Tulsa, Indian Territory, July 14th, 1906.
