I hereby certify that I have carefully and accurately surveyed and staked Lynch and Tracy's addition to the city of Tulsa, D. T. embracing the following described piece of land to wit: - All of that part of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 6, T. 19 N. R. 13 E. lying south of the boundary line between the Cherokee and Creek Nations, with the exception of 40 acres comprising the S. E. 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Sec. 6; also all that part of said NW 1/4 of said Sec. 6 lying northwest of the M. & T. R. R. right of way; also a tract containing 3.09 acres bounded as follows: - Beginning at a point where the North line of the Creek Nation intersects the Range line between Ranges 12 and 13 East; thence east along said Creek Nation Boundary line 450 feet; thence south 300 feet; thence west 450 feet to said Range line; thence north along said Range line 300 feet to the place of beginning.
