This Indenture made and entered into this 16th day of October, One Thousand, Nine Hundred and five, by and between Frank Little and Mabelle T. Little, his wife, of Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, parties of the first part and Frank J. Scott of Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Muscogee or Creek Nation and within the limits of the Indian Territory to-wit: An undivided one-half interest in the West half (W. 1/2), of the West one-half (W. 1/2), of the Southwest quarter (SW. 1/4), of the Northeast quarter (NE. 1/4), and the East half (E. 1/2), of the East half (E. 1/2) of the Southwest quarter (SW. 1/4), of the Northwest quarter (NW. 1/4), of section six (6), Township nineteen (19), North, Range Twelve (12) East, containing twenty (20) acres more or less according to the United States survey, thereof, together with all the improvements, thereon and the appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining thereto.

To Have and to Hold, the aforesaid granted premises to the said F. J. Scott and his heirs and successors in fee simple, forever:

And I, the said Mabelle T. Little, the wife of the said Frank Little, for and in consideration of the sum of money do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part, all my right in and to the said lands.
