## Quit Claim Deed,

This Indenture, made on the Twenty-Seventh (27) day of January A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred Six (1906) by and between F. C. Sheldon and Marion W. Sheldon, his wife, of the County of Jackson, State of Missouri, party of the first part, and Lawrence P. Matthews of the town of Collinville Indian Territory party of the second part,

Witnesseth, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred ~~X~~ ~~—~~ Dollars, to him paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), does by these presents, Remise, Release, and forever Quit claim unto the said party of the second part the following described lots, tracts, or parcels of land, lying, being and situate in the Town of Collinville, Indian Territory, town, all of Lots numbered Seven (7), Eight (8) and Twelve (12) in Block numbered Fifty Eight (58) in the town of Collinville, Indian Territory according to the recorded plot of said town.

To Have and to Hold the same, with all the rights, immunities, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto said party of the second part and unto his heirs and assigns forever, so that neither the said party of the first part nor his heirs, nor any other person or persons for him or in his name or behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof, but they and each of them shall, by these presents, be excluded and forever barred.
