That the parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, paid and secured to be paid as follows, to-wit: One hundred dollars cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged; and Nineteen Hundred Dollars, evidenced by one certain promissory note of even date herewith, made, executed and delivered by the second party, and due and payable to Jackson Techarna and Eliza Techarna on the 19th day of August, 1909, together with six per cent interest from date, the receipt by us of said note is also hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situate in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, to-wit: The North East (1/4) Quarter of Section (13) Thirteen, in Township (16) sixteen north Range (13) Thirteen East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing one hundred and sixty acres, be it more or less as the case may be, according to the Government survey thereof. Said tract of land being the allotment of Louisa Techarna, deceased, together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.

But it is expressly agreed and understood that to secure the payment of the above described note and interest the Vendor's lien is hereby expressly retained on the above described land.
