## General Warranty Deed.

This Indenture, made and entered into this 1st day of July  
one thousand, nine hundred and seven by and between Robert Fife  
a single man, of Tulsa, I. T. party of the first part, and A. H. Purdy,  
of Bristow, Ind. Ter., party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in  
consideration of the sum of Four Hundred forty eight & no/oo Dollars,  
in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does  
hereby, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said  
party of the second part and unto his heirs and assigns, executors  
and administrators forever, the following described Real Estate and  
premises situate in the Muskogee or Creek Nation, and within the  
limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The South East Quarter of  
the North west Quarter, the South half of the south west quarter  
of the North west Quarter, Lot Three (3) and the north half of the  
North half of the south west quarter of Section One (1), Township  
nineteen (19) North and Range Eleven (11) East, with all privileges  
appurtenances and improvements thereupon situate, appertain-  
ing and thereto belonging.

To Have and To Hold The same unto the said A. H. Purdy,  
his heirs and assigns, executors and administrators forever,  
and the said Robert Fife for himself, his heirs and assigns,  
executors and administrators, do covenant with the said A. H.  
Purdy, his heirs and assigns, executors and administrators, that  
he is hereby lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforesigned  
premises; that they are free from all incumbrances, Except -  
that he has a good and lawful right to sell and convey the same  
as herein done, that he will, and his heirs and assigns, execu-  
tors and administrators shall, forever Warrant and Defend the Title  
to the same to the quiet enjoyment of said A. H. Purdy, his heirs  
and assigns, executors and administrators, against all lawful claims,  
and demands of all persons whomever.
