Whereas, I, Jonas Love, a duly enrolled citizen of the Creek Nation, and a convict in the United States Penitentiary at Fort Leavenworth, Missouri, having been convicted under and by the name of Robert Love, and by reason of my confinement as aforesaid I am unable to properly attend to my business and to look after my property in the Creek Nation, and,

Whereas, I am the owner in fee simple, as allottee, of the West half of the South East quarter, and the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section ten (10), Township nineteen (19) North, Range fourteen (14) East in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, and

Whereas, I am desirous of having said land sold, so that the proceeds thereof may be used for my benefit and have selected my mother, Matie Vann Wallace, of Wagoner, Indian Territory, as the person best suited to properly and satisfactorily attend to my said business.

Now Therefore, Know all men By These Presents:

That I, Jonas Love, for and in consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents doth hereby make, constitute and appoint, irrevocably, Matie Vann Wallace, of Wagoner, Indian Territory, my true and lawful attorney in fact, for me and in my name, peace and stead, to sell and convey all of my right, title and interest in and to the West half of the South East quarter, and the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section ten (10), Township nineteen (19) North, Range fourteen (14) East in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, for such price as to her, my ^{said} attorney in fact, may seem right and reasonable; in my name to execute, acknowledge and deliver to the purchaser or purchasers of said land, or any part or portion thereof she may sell, proper deed or deeds of conveyance, conveying to said purchaser or purchasers all of my right, title and interest in and to said above described lands, with the improvements thereon, to receive and receipt for the purchase price of said lands, and to do and perform all acts, and do all things, legally necessary and proper to be done to carry into effect my purpose as herein expressed, hereby giving and granting unto my said attorney in fact, full power and authority in the premises, and hereby ratifying and
