Key, heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said J. M. Key, heirs and assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
