Grocery Co., and agree to hold the same in my possession subject to the order, either verbal or written, and to make no disposition or removal of said property from the place where it is now located without the written consent, and also to care for said property satisfactorily to the said Britton & Co. Grocery Co. for the consideration before stated and without any additional cost to said Britton & Co. Grocery Co., it being expressly understood that said property is held at all times subject to the order of the said Britton & Co. Grocery Co.
