Chauncey A. Owen,

Henceforth known by these Presents:

That The First National Bank of Tulsa, Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to it paid, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Chauncey A. Owen and unto his heirs and assigns forever the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot Five (5) in Block Fourteen (14); Lots Three, Four and Five (3, 4 & 5) in Block Sixty (60); and Seventy-five (75) ft. by Ninety-two (92) ft., beginning seventy-five (75) ft. north of the S.E. corner of Lot Two (2) in Block Sixty (60), thence S.W. paralleling the sides of said block for Ninety-two (92) ft., thence NW paralleling Main St. Twenty-five (25) ft., thence Ninety-two (92) ft. NE, thence Twenty-five (25) ft. SE to point of beginning all in the original town of Tulsa, Indian Territory.

This deed being given in release of a certain mortgage dated Jan. 24, 1906 and filed for record in the office of the clerk of the U.S. Court at Sapulpa, Indian Territory, in book "L" at page 514, said mortgage being given by said Chauncey A. Owen and Mary Owen, his wife, to The First National Bank of Tulsa, Indian Territory; and the full payment of said mortgage is hereby completed and the land reconveyed to the said Chauncey A. Owen,
