Brewer and Susie Byrd being of lawful age and first duly sworn upon their oaths depose and say that they know Amanda Byrd in her life time and know of their own personal knowledge that she died on September 11, 1904; that she was a Cherokee Freedman, and that all of these affairs are Cherokee Freedman, and were personally known to the deceased; that said Amanda Byrd is the identical person to whom was allotted as a member of the Cherokee Tribe of Indians in the Indian Territory, the following described lands situated in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south half of the south-west quarter of the southwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the south-west quarter of the southwest quarter of section nine (9) Township twenty-two (22) north, Range thirteen (13) east; that at the time of her death said deceased was about twenty-two (22) years of age.
