 of the United States, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00)
 Dollar, to it paid by Frank Trueler and Phoebe B. Trueler, his wife, does
 hereby grant, sell, quit claim and release unto the said Frank Trueler and
 Phoebe B. Trueler, his wife, and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the
 following described real estate lying in the Western District of the Indian
 Territory, to wit: all of the north half (1/2) of the northwest quarter (1/4) of
 section Two (2), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Thirteen (13) East,
 in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of trust
 dated May 7, 1907, and recorded May 10, 1907, in Book 3, at Page 274
 of the records of the 28th Recording District of the Indian Territory,
 by Frank Trueler and Phoebe B. Trueler, his wife, conveying said real
 estate to the said City National Bank to secure the payment of one
 certain promissory note therein named, the same having been fully
 paid.

 Territory, has, by its Cashier, duly authorized thereto, subscribed its
