That I, W. A. Hobbs of Shawnee, O. T., for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Twenty five Dollars to me in hand by W. M. Watson, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. M. Watson his heirs and assigns forever, all my interest in the following described property or land lying in the Northern District of the Indian Territory to-wit: The East One Half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Lot (1) Block Sixty Nine (49) in the town of Red Forks, according to the United States survey and official plat of said town, approved by the acting Secretary of the Interior of the United States, February 20, 1902.

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. M. Watson, his heirs and assigns forever with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And I hereby covenant with said W. M. Watson that I will forever warrant and defend, the title to the said lands against all claimants whatever.

And I, Emma J. Hobbs, wife of the said W. A. Hobbs and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. M. Watson all my right, title, and interest in and to the said land. Witness our hands and seals on this, 28 day of August 1905.
