

be made in the payment of said indebtedness, as herein set forth, or should party of the first part (prior to full payment of above mentioned indebtedness) sell, attempt to sell, ship, remove or otherwise dispose of the property herein conveyed, or any part thereof without the consent in writing, of the party of the second party, or in case the party of the second part shall deem, that in order to properly protect his interests and secure full payment of above mentioned indebtedness, such action shall be necessary then, in either event, the party of the second part, his agent or attorney, is hereby authorized and empowered to take charge of said property on demand, without process of law, and sell or dispose of the same, or so much as may be necessary at public sale without appraisement (the appraisement required by law being hereby expressly waived) at Bixby, I. T. in cash in hand, upon two weeks notice in some newspaper published in the Western District of the Indian Territory, or by written notices posted in five conspicuous places near the property, at which sale any of the parties hereto may purchase as other parties, and out of the proceeds of the said sale the said party of the second part to retain the sum due it as herein set forth, and the cost of this trust and of sale, rendering the overplus, if any, to the said party of the first part his executors, administrators or assigns.
