Know all men by these Presents; That Mary Nelson (a single and unmarried woman, of Tahlequah, Cherokee Nation, Western District, of the Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar & other valuable considerations Dollars \$1.00) to me paid by E. L. Halsell, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I unite, release, sell, quit claim and convey unto the said E. L. Halsell his heirs and assigns, all the right, title, claim and demand, I have in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, lying and being situate in the - of Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, to-wit:

The northwest quarter of the southeast quarter and the south half of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section thirty three (33) Township twenty three (23), North, range four - teen (14) east, containing seventy acres, more or less, being the allotment of Clay Simpson, deceased.

To Have and To Hold the same, with all the right, immunities, privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said E. L. Halsell, his heirs and assigns, forever, so that neither the said Mary Nelson, nor, my heirs, nor any other person or persons for me or in my name or behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the aforesaid premises or any part thereof, but they and every one of the shall, by these presents, be excluded and forever barred.
