This instrument, made this 4th day of September, A. D. 1907 between Lynde-Bowman-Darby Company, a corporation duly created, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the United States in force in the Indian Territory, of Evans, Indian Territory, Western District, party of the first part, and R. J. Stock and Jackson Thompson of Cheekish, Indian Territory, Western District, parties of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five & no/oo Dollars, in hand paid by the said parties of the second part (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) has demised, released, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents, does remise, release, sell and convey and quit claim unto the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements situated in the Creek Notion, Indian Territory, Western District, and known and described as follows, to wit:

The East half of the South East quarter and the South West quarter of the South East quarter of section three (3) Township Nineteen (19) North and Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Base and Meridian in the Indian Territory, containing One hundred Twenty (120) acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States Survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges therunto belonging or appertaining and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part, either in law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever.
