Know All Men By these Presents, That, Whereas, on the 20th day of Oct, A. D. 1900, a mortgage was executed by Albert G. Maxfield and Mary Maxfield, his wife, to Loren Conaway, for the consideration therein expressed, upon the following property, to wit:

Now, in consideration of the payment of said indebtedness in full and other considerations to me in hand paid by said Albert G. Maxfield and Mary Maxfield, his wife the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have granted, released, quitclaimed and set over, and by these presents do hereby grant, release, quitclaim and set over unto the said Albert G. Maxfield his heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to said mortgaged property, together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the intent that the property hereby conveyed may be discharged from said mortgage.

To have and to hold the lands and premises hereby released and conveyed unto the said Albert G. Maxfield, his heirs and assigns, and to their proper uses, benefit and behoof, forever, free, clear and discharged of and from all lien and claim under and by virtue of the mortgage aforesaid.
