Know all men by These Presents, that I, C. O. Robinson, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty three and 33/100 dollars (\$53.33) lawful money of the United States, to me in hand paid by Charles Impey, the receipt thereof being hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over, unto the said Charles Impey, an undivided one-half of my interest in said lease, to have and to hold the same, unto the said Charles Impey, his heirs and assigns forever.

The interest in said lease hereby transferred to said Charles Impey, being an undivided one-tenth working interest.
