Release of Mortgage,

I know all men by these presents, That the Farm and Home Savings and Loan Association of Missouri, a corporation organized and doing business under the laws of Missouri, at the city of Tulsa, in said state, for and in consideration of One Dollar, and for other valuable considerations the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, convey, release, satisfy, discharge and quit claim unto J. A. Friend and his wife Julia A. Friend, of Tulsa, Indian Territory, all the right, title, interest, claim or demand whatsoever, it may have acquired in, through or by a certain mortgage, bearing date June 20th, 1906, and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court for the Western District of the Indian Territory, at Tulsa, in Book I. at Page 51, to the premises herein described, as follows: all of Lot Number Two (2), except that part described as a tract ten (10) feet wide and Fifty (50) feet long, commencing in the southwesterly corner of said Lot Two (2) lying ten (10) feet along the westerly line of said lot from said corner southerly, and extending easterly along the northerly side of the southerly line of said lot, a distance of fifty (50) feet, a uniform width of ten (10) feet all in Block Number One Hundred and Six (106) in the Town (now city) of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the official Plot and Survey thereof and all improvements thereon, together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining.
