Shippen, of Wagoner, Indian Territory, party of the second part, covering ^{for a period of five years, from date,} the following described premises, to-wit: (The southeast quarter (4) of the Northeast quarter (14) of Section Twelve (12), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, same being the homestead allotment of said Alex. Bruner, and,

Whereas, said rental contract was duly filed for record in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court, at Wagoner, Indian Territory, and duly entered of record in Record Book—, at Page, on the 7th day of December, 1905,

Now, Therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of one (\$1.00) Dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and other valuable considerations, the said party of the second part hereby releases, releases, relinquishes, quit-claims and sets over unto said Alex. Bruner, all of his right, title and interest in and to the above described premises to the end that the same may be declared free of said lease, and party of the second part hereby acknowledges satisfaction in full for said lease.
