Rental Contract for Agricultural Purposes.

Made and executed this 21st day of Dec., 1906, by and between Ruth Ketcher of Oktoville, far and on behalf of herself age 25 years, party of the first part (hereinafter called the lessor,) and P. J. Dore, party of the second part (hereinafter called, the lessee.)

Now, Therefore, In consideration of \$320⁰⁰ cash, as full payment on said rents herein provided, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the lessor will to the lessee, his successors and assigns, the following described tract of land situated in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, to wit; Lot 182 sec (a) & SW 1/4 acres of Lot 4 of sec (1) 30 acres in lot 4 sec 1 Section 182 Township 23 Range 12 E. 120 acres.

To have and to hold said premises for agricultural purpose, during the term of 5 years, and the said lessor hereby rents the same for the sum of \$320⁰⁰ for full term, payable as follows, all in cash now paid.

The lessor agrees that possession to above lands shall be given on or before Jan'y 1, 1907, but if possession is not so given on or before said date, then rents are to commence from date of possession.

All improvements placed on said land by the lessee, or his assigns, may be removed by them at or before the expiration, of this contract.

No contract other or different from this shall ever be claimed by either of the parties hereto unless the same is in writing and signed by each of them.
