Deed of Dedication,

Know all men by these presents: That the Union Land and Investment Company of Muskogee, Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable consideration, do hereby dedicate to the use of the public generally, for public purposes, forever, all the streets and alleys as shown on a certain plat prepared by J. Robert Burnham of Tulsa Indian Territory, and now on file in the office of the clerk of the United States Court for the Western District of Indian Territory, at Tulsa, described as the North east quarter of the south east quarter of Section Twelve Township nineteen north and Range Twelve east; containing 40 acres more or less and situated in the Western District of Indian Territory.

To have and to hold the said lands to the public forever,
