Know all men by these presents, that whereas on the 19th day of October, 1905, Jasper Early and Henrietta Berryhill Early made and executed to Luther Opry, at certain rental contract for a period of five (5) years from date, covering, among other lands, the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section one (1), Township seventeen (17) North, and Range fourteen (44) East, and,

Whereas, on the 23rd day of July, 1906, the said Luther Opry, for a good and valuable consideration, transferred and assigned all his right, title and interest in and to said lease to C. W. Lumpkin, and,

Whereas, on the 17th day of August, 1907, the said C. W. Lumpkin transferred and assigned all his right, title and interest in and to said lease to J. C. Pinson, for a good and valuable consideration,

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to me in hand paid, I, J. C. Pinson, do hereby transfer and assign all my right, title and interest in and to the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section one (1), Township seventeen (17) North, and Range fourteen (44) East, obtained under said lease, to J. J. Richardson.

and I, J. C. Pinson, hereby covenant with the said J. J. Richardson that I have no good right to execute this transfer and that I will, and my heirs, executors and administrators shall, warrant and defend the title to the said lease against all persons whatsoever.
