Partial Deed of Release,

Frank E. Morse,

Know All Men By These Presents:

That I, G. W. Smith for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me paid by Frank E. Morse, owner of the property that is herein after released, do hereby grant, sell, quit claim and release unto the said Frank E. Morse, and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate in the town of North Tulsa, Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory described as - Beginning at the south east corner of Lot Seven (7) in Block Twenty (20) thence running north westerly along alley line 48.7 feet, thence running southwesterly parallel to and 88 feet distant from line between lots seven and eight to boundary line thence east along boundary line to place of beginning.

This deed being given to release a portion of the land described in a certain deed of mortgage April 9, 1906 and recorded April 28, 1906 at Sapulpa, 8th Recording District, Indian Territory being file no. 11508 by William J. Neet and Mary Neet, his wife conveying Lot 7 in Block 20 in North Tulsa, Addition to Tulsa except the north 12 feet of said lot.

Also that portion of Lot 3 Blk. 6 in Tulsa as follows: Beginning at north west corner of said lot 3 thence south 13 feet along Boston Ave. thence east 31 feet to the line dividing the Creek Nation and Cherokee Nation thence west along said dividing line to place of beginning - to G. W. Smith to secure payment of one certain note of \$216.00 therein named. This instrument releasing only the tract of land first herein described.
