This agreement made this 29th day of August, 1907, by and between Henry A. Elliott of Bartlesville, Ind. Ter., party of the first part, and James D. Ward of Collinsville, Ind. Ter., party of the second part, is to the effect that the party of first part is this day and by this agreement has lease to party of second part, the following described land, - S.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4, and N.W. 1/4 of N.E. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4, and, lot two, sit in Section five, Township twenty-one, range fourteen, in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory for the sum of one thousand twelve, \$1200 Dollars, of which amount the sum of Fifty Dollars has this day been paid to party of first part by party of second part, the receipt of which the party of the first part hereby acknowledges, for oil and Gas purposes for a period of fifteen years, according to Government rules and regulations, the balance of the purchase money to be paid to party of first part on the making by him to party of second part of the Government lease on this land, and the party of the first part to make said lease at request of party of second part. The party of first part hereby states that he has good right to lease the above land, that he has not executed any former lease that will interfere with this agreed on lease.
