Quit Claim Deed.

Richard O. Trent.

This Indenture, made this 28th day of September, 1907, between Roy D. Palmer and Georgie H. Palmer his wife, parties of the first part, of Coffeyville, Kansas, and Richard O. Trent, party of the second part, of Amarillo, Texas.

Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have remise, released, sold, conveyed, quitclaimed, and by these presents do remise, release, sell, convey and grant unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, the right to perpetual occupancy thereof, and do also grant and assign all the right, title, interest, claim and possession which the said parties of the first part have in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, situated in Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, and described as follows, to-wit:

The Northwest Quarter (34) of the Southwest quarter (34) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Twenty-three (23) North of Range Thirteen (13) East of the 1st M; and the West Half (32) of the Southwest quarter (34) of the Northwest quarter (34) and the Northeast quarter (34) of the Southwest quarter (34) of the Northeast quarter (34) of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Twenty-three (23) North of Range Thirteen (13) East of the 1st M., containing Seventy (70) acres.

To Have and To Hold the same together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim of the said parties of the first part, either in law or equity, forever.
