John F. Rogers,

Know all men By These Presents: That I, George B. Blackburn, an unmarried man, for and in the consideration of the sum of One Dollar, to me paid by John F. Rogers, do hereby grant sell, quit-claim and release unto the said John F. Rogers, and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit: Lot One (1) in Block One Hundred and Ninety Eight (198) in the Town of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the official plat thereof.

This deed being made to release the lien of a certain deed of mortgage dated 13th day of May, 1907, and recorded May 16th 1907, in Book 3, at Page 281, of the records of the 28th Recording District of the Indian Territory, by John F. Rogers and wife conveying said real estate to the said George B. Blackburn, to secure the payment of one certain promissory note for \$725.00 therein named, the same having been fully paid.
