Beard as soon as thirty days expire after removal of his restrictions the N.E. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of NE 1/4 and S.E. ten acres of Lot one (1) and no. 20 $\frac{34}{100}$ acres Lot one (1) all in Section three (3) Twp. 22 N. Range 14 E. in Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, said Griffin acknowledges payment to him of \$150.00 on said land by said Beard.

R. B. Beard agrees to pay the balance of the purchase price for said land as soon as said Griffin complies with the original contract of purchase of said lands, dated November, 13th, 1907.
