

Oil and Gas Lease

This agreement made and entered into on this 5th day of November 1907, by and between John S. Thomason, and his wife Rachel F. Thomason, John C. Starr, and his wife Libbie B. Starr, Oliver Bagby, and his Mary E. Bagby, all of Vinita Indian Territory parties of the first part, and The Shawnee Oil and Gas Company, a corporation of Collinville Indian Territory party of the second part

Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter contained and the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3000⁰⁰) in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, demise, and let unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns for the purposes and exclusive right of drilling mining and operating for and procuring oil and gas all of the following described property to-wit: - The south west quarter (S.W. 4) of the south east quarter (S.E. 4) and the north west quarter (N.W. 4) of the south east quarter (S.E. 4) of the south east quarter (S.E. 4) of section 10 or 12, township twenty-one (21) north Range Twelve (12) east of the Indian base and meridian in the Cherokee Nation Indian Territory to any extent the said party of the second part may deem advisable, together with the right to lay, erect and maintain all necessary pipe and pipe lines, tanks, structures, rods, cables and all other fixtures and machinery used in drilling for pumping, preserving, storing, and transporting the products on said premises. The party of the second part shall further have the right to use sufficient water from the premises for operating purposes and if necessary the right to drill for it on said premises. Also the right to use all necessary gas and oil for operating purposes on this lease.
