Discharge of Mortgage.

All that portion of Lot Three (3) in Block Seventy-six (76) of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of said Lot Three (3); thence in a northerly direction along the west line of said lot; thence in an easterly direction along the north line of said lot forty (40) feet; thence in a southerly direction one hundred (100) feet in a line parallel with the west line of said lot; and forty (40) feet distant therefrom to the south line of said lot. Thence west forty (40) feet along the south line of said lot three (3) to place of beginning, same being west forty (40) feet of said lot, according to plat and survey, which said mortgage is recorded in the office of the Deputy U.
