Deed of Release.
Know all Men By These Presents

That The Union Trust Company (an Indian Territory Corporation) of Tulsa Oklahoma, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty One Hundred Twenty Five ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars to it paid by Edward J. Slater do hereby grant sell quitclaim and release unto the said Ella V. Slater & Edward J. Slater her husband and unto their heirs and assigns forever the following described real estate lying in the Tulsa County, Oklahoma formerly Western District of the Indian Territory to wit:

Full of Lot Four (4) in Block One Hundred Seventy Three (173) in Tulsa Tulsa County, Oklahoma according to the recorded plat thereof.

This deed being made to release (only so far as it affects the above described property) the lien of certain Mortgage dated May 4th 1907 and recorded May 4th 1907 at 2 P.M. in Book 11 at page 23 of the records of Mortgages at Tulsa Ind. Terr.

This deed of release is made by the undersigned officer of the Union Trust Company in pursuance of the authority conferred upon him in Article VII of the bylaws of said Company as follows:

"The Secretary shall have equal power with the President to satisfy and release mortgages, judgments or certificates of trust, to execute contracts releases or other instruments in the transaction of the company's business."
