Of Missouri a corporation organized and doing business under the laws of Missouri at the City of Nevada, in said State, for and in consideration of One Dollar and for other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby remise, convey, release, satisfy, discharge and quit claim unto Henry Hornecker, Single and Unmarried of Tulsa Indian Territory, all the right, title, interest, claim or demand and whatsoever it may have acquired in through or by a certain mortgage bearing date August 20th 1906 and recorded in the office of the Clerk of the United States Court for the Western District of the Indian Territory at Tulsa in Book 6 at Page 495. to the premises herein described as follows: The Westerly Premier River (25) feet by One Hundred and Twenty (120) feet of Lot Numbered One (1) and Two (2) in Block Number Seventy Four (74) having a frontage of twenty-five (25) feet on East River Street and running back Northwesterly with a uniform width of twenty-five (25) feet along the Westerly line of said Lots One (1) and Two (2) a distance of one hundred and twenty (120) feet to the St. Louis and San Francisco Rail Road right of way, in the Town of Tulsa Indian Territory, as shown per the Official Plat and survey thereof, and all improvements thereon, together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining.
